## WALK THE LINE CALLTOACTION

## We are looking for 9 participants in an itinerant walking project for creating a new border narrative!

Walk the line is a project of the Cultural Association Altrememorie, financed by the Friuli-Venezia Giulia Region, within the framework of the enhancement of the historical and ethnographic heritage.

From Sunday 1st September to Friday 6 September, the association Altrememorie in cooperation with the anthropologist Janine Schemmer, the writer and journalist Nicolò Giraldi, the nature guide Leonardo Cerno, the photographer Giovanni Chiarot and the architect Matteo Carli will lead a walk in stages from Stolvizza (Val Resia) to Monte Forno (Tarvisio), following and crossing the Italian-Slovenian border line. The group will be composed of 9 university students - 3 Italians, 3 Slovenians and 3 Austrians - who will gather the suggestions, emotions and ideas that the landscape and their experience will inspire in them.

A collective tale of memories, stories and landscapes of a border stretch with a strong cultural, historical and political value. A narrative in movement in which the personal gaze of each participant will be stimulated and encouraged, within the common dimension of this experience.

The participants will backpack for about 20 km a day along a route of pre-established paths. Each day experts, artists and writers will be invited to join the walk, enriching the experience of the journey and the transcultural dimension. Registration costs 100€ per participant. Board and lodging will be provided by the organisation, while transport costs to the starting point (Stolvizza) and back from the finishing point must be covered individually.

All the material produced will be synthesised into a choral work that will be publicly accessible on an online platform, thanks to the support of a team of multimedia communication creatives. Everyone's visions, matured and elaborated day by day during the route, will be shared and reworked together.

The route is challenging, both in terms of the altitude difference and the distances to be covered each day. It is therefore essential that participants have good physical condition and experience in hiking. Each participant must be autonomous with regard to personal equipment, bringing the necessary equipment to face five days in the mountains, including overnight stays in a refuge or bivouac.
